This letter included the date, time and location for the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing and Issue Specific Hearing into the draft Development Consent Order, this is reflected in the amended timetable below at **items 17** and **18**.

Further to the amended examination timetable contained in Annex A of my Rule 8(3) letter of 8 August 2019, a variation of the timetable has been made now under Rule 8(3) and this is contained in Annex A of this letter at **items 16, 17, 18, 19** and **20**.
