## EXAMINATION OF THE RIVERSIDE ENERGY PARK DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER APPLICATION BY CORY ENVIRONMENTAL HOLDINGS LIMITED (THE "REP APPLICATION")

## **REFERENCE: EN010093**

- 1. We write on behalf of Western Riverside Waste Authority ("WRWA") in respect of the REP Application which was accepted by the Secretary of State for examination on 14 December 2018.
- 2. Following recent discussions between WRWA and Cory Environmental Holdings Limited ("Cory"), we can confirm that a commercial agreement has been reached which resolves WRWA's objections to the REP Application and includes the acquisition of WRWA's interests in the Order land.
