## **EXAMINATION OF THE RIVERSIDE ENERGY PARK DEVELOPMENT CONSENT** ORDER APPLICATION BY CORY ENVIRONMENTAL HOLDINGS LIMITED (THE "REP APPLICATION")

## REFERENCE: EN010093

- 1. We write on behalf of Landsul Limited ("Landsul") and Munster Joinery (U.K.) Limited ("Munster") in respect of the REP Application which was accepted by the Secretary of State for examination on 14 December 2018.
- 2. As you will be aware, Landsul and Munster had land within the Order land at the time the REP Application was made but, following changes made at Deadline 2 by the Applicant (Cory Environmental Holdings Limited ("Cory")), they now no longer have any land interests within the Order land.
- 3. However, Landsul and Munster have submitted the following submissions to the examination:
- 3.1 relevant Representation by Landsul (RR-063);
- 3.2 relevant Representation by Munster (RR-065);
- 3.3 submission at deadline 3 relating to access arrangements off Norman Road (REP3-046); and
- 3.4 an application for costs to the Planning Inspectorate, dated 14 June 2019.
- Following recent discussions between Landsul, Munster and Cory, we can 4. confirm that Landsul and Munster are satisfied that the issues raised in the

documents referred to at paragraphs 3.1 to 3.3 above have been satisfactorily addressed. On this basis we can confirm that Landsul and Munster withdraw their objections and those representations and submissions to the REP Application and that neither company wishes to participate further in the Examination.

5. Further, Cory has reached an agreement with Landsul and Munster in respect of their costs application referred to at paragraph 3.4 above. Therefore, both Landsul and Munster withdraw this application for costs and do not wish for the examining authority to consider it further.
