### 4. SOUTHERN GAS NETWORK (SGN)

4.1 The Applicant has received confirmation from SGN that the protective provisions and side agreement are now agreed. The side agreement has been signed by the Applicant and is currently in the process of being signed by SGN. The Applicant will update the ExA once the side agreement has been completed but understands that SGN will be writing to the Examination to withdraw its objection.

### 5. NATIONAL GRID ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION PLC (NATIONAL GRID)

5.1 The Applicant has received confirmation from National Grid that the protective provisions are agreed and that the side agreement has been signed and will be completed today, 9 October 2019. The Applicant understands that once the side agreement has been completed that National Grid will be writing to the ExA to withdraw its objection.

### 6. NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED (NETWORK RAIL)

6.1 The Applicant and Network Rail have agreed the protective provisions included in the **Draft DCO (3.1, Rev 5)** submitted at Deadline 8b. The Applicant and Network Rail have also agreed the terms of an undertaking which is required by Network Rail before it is able to withdraw its objection to the Application. That document is in the process of being executed and it is expected that it will be completed prior to the close of the Examination at midnight on 9 October 2019. It is also expected that Network Rail will be in a position to withdraw its objection to the Application prior to the close of the Examination.

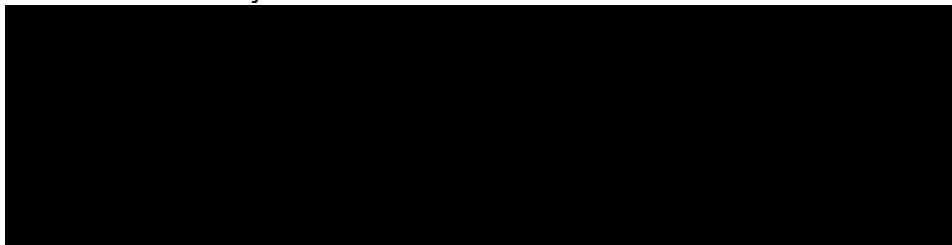
