7. The Applicant's **Fourth Report on Outstanding Submissions** (document reference 9.90) to respond to additional submissions at Deadline 7.

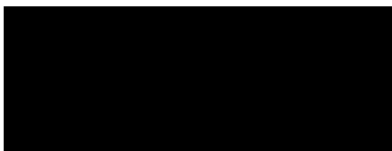
