Further to the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero (DESNZ) letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023, please find enclosed with this letter the following document which has been requested from the Applicant:

1. An Addendum to the Outline Ornithological Compensation Implementation and Monitoring Plan (document reference 9.116) specifically relating to providing further information on adaptive monitoring and management.

A revised draft Development Consent Order was not requested by the Secretary of State and has not been provided. However, should the Secretary of State make the Order, the Applicant requests that the addendum referred to above is incorporated into Part 1 of Schedule 10 to the Order in the following manner. This ensures that the commitments set out in the addendum are secured through the Order.

The Applicant reiterates their position on the application and associated environmental matters as summarised in the Summary of Case (document reference 9.113) submitted 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Since issuing of this document the Applicant (and other Interested Parties) have submitted further information to the Secretary of State. None of the information changes the Applicant's view that (i) appropriate attention has been paid to all likely significant environmental effects with appropriate mitigation provided where applicable (ii) that the case for the development has been made and (iii) that the application is consistent with the current and draft National Policy statements (NPSs). Additionally, the Applicant is still of the view that no Adverse Effects on Integrity (AEoI) of any National Network site will result due to the construction, operation or decommissioning of the Facility. Information has been provided on a without

prejudice case in terms of compensation which, if the Secretary of State deems AEoI provides for the required measures to be put in place and secured by the DCO.

I should be grateful if you would acknowledge safe receipt of this letter and arrange for a copy of it and its enclosures to be placed before DESNZ.
