VPI IMMINGHAM OCGT PROJECT – APPLICATION FOR A NEW GAS-FIRED POWER STATION AND ASSOCIATED DEVELOPMENT – LAND TO THE WEST OF ROSPER ROAD, SOUTH KILLINGHOLME, LINCOLNSHIRE, DN40 3DZ

We write on behalf of VPI Immingham B Limited ('VPIB' or the 'Applicant') in respect of its application for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') to construct, operate and maintain a new gas-fired electricity generating station with a gross output capacity of up to 299 megawatts ('MW'), including electrical and gas supply connections, and other associated development (the 'Proposed Development').

The Proposed Development is located primarily on land (the 'Site') to the north of the existing VPI Immingham Power Station, Rosper Road, South Killingholme, North Lincolnshire, DN40 3DZ.

In accordance with Sections 58 and 59 of the Planning Act 2008 (the 'PA 2008'), Regulation 10 of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 and Regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the '2017 EIA Regulations'), please find enclosed the following:
