We are instructed by Phillips 66 Limited, who were present at the Preliminary Meeting held on 8 August 2019, and filed a Relevant Representation on 25 June 2019 in relation to this project.

Whilst Deadline 1 of your final examination timetable will make provision for representation as to the need for an accompanied site visit (ASI) we thought it would be helpful if we alerted you now to the need, in our submission, for an ASI to be carried out on our client's site. We also need to flag that there are security and safety protocols that will need to be observed for this site visit.

It is critical that you are able to see first-hand the route of the pipelines through key parts of our client's facility; the Humber Oil Refinery. The facility is an upper tier COMAH site (Control of Major Accident Hazards Regulations 1999).
