- As noted in our Written Representation for Deadline 2 there are interfaces in terms of potentially conflicting rights and powers and potential interference with property interests, infrastructure and works within plots 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 68, 69, 70, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 90, 91, and 92 of the draft VPI Immingham OCGT Development Consent Order.
- 2.3 We are continuing to work with the Applicant to seek to agree protective provisions or other suitable protections. We would be happy to provide a Statement of Common Ground detailing agreement reached/outstanding areas of concern and will discuss this with the Applicant.
