I write further to Highways England's Deadline 4 submission dated 14 November 2019.

I am pleased to confirm that Highways England has now reached agreement with the Applicant as to the terms of protective measures for the benefit of Highways England's interest in the strategic road network ("SRN") crossed by the existing gas pipeline in two place. Measures to overcome any inappropriate or uncontrolled impacts or use of the SRN as a consequence of the wide application of compulsory acquisition and other powers in the dDCO have now been secured.
