**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO MAKE A NON-MATERIAL CHANGE TO THE FOLLOWING
DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER:**

THE IMMINGHAM OPEN CYCLE GAS TURBINE ORDER 2020 (S.I. 2020 NO. 847)

1. Notice is hereby given that VPI Immingham B Limited (the 'Applicant') of 4th Floor, Nova South, 160 Victoria Street, London, SW1E 5LB, is seeking non-material changes to 'The Immingham Open Cycle Gas Turbine Order 2020' (the 'Order') (S.I. 2020 No. 847) by way of an application (the 'Non-Material Change Application') submitted to the Secretary of State ('SoS') for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.
2. The Order was made by the SoS pursuant to Section 114 'Grant or refusal of development consent' of 'The Planning Act 2008' on 7 August 2020. The Order came into force on 1 September 2020.
3. The Order grants development consent, subject to certain provisions, for the 'Authorised Development' comprising the construction, operation and maintenance of an electricity generating station comprising an Open Cycle Gas Turbine ('OCGT') power station with a gross electrical output of up to 299 megawatts and associated development. The OCGT power station is known as the VPI 'B' Project. The VPI 'B' Project Site, where the OCGT power station will be constructed, comprises land north of the VPI Combined Heat and Power Power Station, Rosper Road, Immingham, Lincolnshire, DN40 3DZ.

Summary of the Proposed Non-Material Changes

4. The Applicant is proposing the following non-material changes to the Order:
 - (i) The inclusion of a Synchronous Condenser under Work No. 1 at Schedule 1 'Authorised Development' of the Order.
 - (ii) The amendment of Requirement 11(3) 'Flood Risk' at Schedule 2 of the Order to amend the trigger for the submission of the mitigation of operational flood risk.
5. The Non-Material Change Application seeks to make the above changes to the Order and includes a draft Amendment Order.
