Good afternoon,

Following receipt of the Regulation 7 letter from DWD on behalf of VPI Immingham B Limited dated 13 December 2023 please find the comments of North Lincolnshire Council (NLC) (host authority) below:

It is understood that the proposed change to The Immingham Open Cycle Gas Turbine Order relate to the design parameters, set out in Table 9 of Schedule 12 as follows:

1. To increase the maximum length of the Single gas turbine from 30m to 31m;
2. To increase the maximum length of the gas turbine building from 46m to 50m; and
3. To increase the maximum width of the gas turbine building from 25m to 35m.

NLC has reviewed the Non-Material Change Application documents and agree that the proposed amendments do not present any material changes to the Immingham Open Cycle Gas Turbine Order. The changes are minor in nature and are unlikely to result in any significant additional or materially different environmental considerations. On this basis NLC has no objection to the proposed changes, which it considers to be non-material in nature.
