Harbour Energy Deadline 1 Submission re. Hornsea Project Four

1. On 16 Dec 2021, Harbour Energy registered its interest as Operator of Oil & Gas production licenses P.686 and P.380 which contain the producing gas field known as Johnston located in Blocks 43/26a and 43/27a. For the avoidance of doubt, Harbour Energy is the parent company of Premier Oil E&P UK EU Limited who acts on behalf of itself and its joint venture partner in the Johnston Field, Dana Petroleum (E&P) Limited. All statements in this submission are therefore made on behalf of both Premier Oil E&P UK EU Limited and Dana Petroleum (E&P) Limited.
2. Harbour Energy advises:
 - It does not wish to speak at a Compulsory Action Hearing (CAH)
 - It does not wish to speak at an Open Floor Hearing (OFH)
 - It does not expect to need to speak at any of the scheduled Issue Specific Hearings (ISH1 – ISH6). However, should the ExA request an oral submission at any of these meetings or at ISH7 or ISH8, Harbour Energy will be happy to comply with such a request.
 - It does not wish to propose any sites for an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI)
3. Harbour Energy requests that future correspondence be received electronically and asks that this be sent to both:

4. Harbour Energy proposes to provide the ExA with a comprehensive Written Representation by Deadline 2 which will clarify the impact of the Proposal should it be approved and will also set out mitigating measures which, if agreed to by the Applicant or if required by the SoS by means of Protective Provisions to the DCO would ensure successful coexistence.
5. Following a pause to accommodate the merger of Premier Oil with Chrysaor Energy to form Harbour Energy, Harbour Energy is pleased to advise that efforts are being made to recommence the constructive dialogue that had been conducted with the Applicant and remains optimistic that a Coexistence Agreement may be entered into before the close of the Examination.
