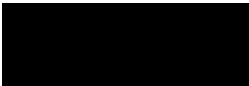

We also noted under Item 2.1 reference made to matters concerning the intertidal zone. We therefore suggest that the Examination Authority might wish to discuss such matters with the relevant local planning authority (East Riding of Yorkshire Council) and their archaeological advisory service; as we appreciate that they might be participating in Issue Specific Hearing 2 (Onshore environmental matters).
