Application by Ørsted Hornsea Project Four Limited for an Order granting Development Consent for the proposed Hornsea Project Four Offshore Wind Farm

Request for further information and written comments

The Examining Authority (ExA) writes to the Applicant following its review of the responses submitted by Natural England (NE) for Deadlines 3 and 4.

The ExA considers that issues have been raised which are both important and relevant to the Examination. The ExA therefore makes a written request under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 for the Applicant to engage further in the Examination.

In relation to the seabird baseline characterisation data and the use and interpretation of MRSea, NE [REP4-055] has advised that, in its opinion, the original model-based estimates are not fit for purpose and cannot be reliably used to inform the assessment of impacts within the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) or the Report to Inform Appropriate Assessment (RIAA), potential compensation requirements or future cumulative or in-combination assessments. To ensure that sufficient progress is made on these matters prior to the close of the Examination, NE has suggested that a revised baseline would need to be agreed for key species and subsequent assessments undertaken for submission into the Examination at Deadline 5. NE has made suggestions about a possible way forward and offered to work with the Applicant to secure this.



The ExA requests the Applicant to indicate its broad intention in relation to this advice from the statutory nature conservation body that a revised baseline and assessment should now be submitted and its offer of assistance, and - if any further work in this respect is to be carried out – whether it would be completed for submission at Deadline 5.

Timetable variation

As a result of this request, it is necessary to amend the Examination Timetable.

Procedural Decision

The revised Examination Timetable is attached at **Annex A**. This replaces the timetable that was issued with the Rule 8 letter [PD-007] dated 28 February 2022.

The Examination Timetable has been revised as follows:

- Deadline 4a: In order to enable a prompt response to the request for information in relation to the seabird baseline characterisation data and the use and interpretation of MRSea the ExA has set a new deadline of Wednesday 25 May 2022 (Deadline 4a). For the avoidance of doubt the ExA is not seeking information or a response from any other party at this deadline.
- 2. **Deadline 5:** As a result of the creation of Deadline 4a, the second last bullet point in Deadline 5 has been amended to read 'Comments on responses submitted for Deadlines 4 and 4a'.

In addition, the ExA has taken the opportunity provided by revising the Examination Timetable to make the following additional revisions:

- 3. **Dates reserved (if required):** The ExA has not received any requests to hold an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) under Rule 16 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Regulations 2010. Having confirmed this at the close of Issue Specific Hearing (ISH) 6 [EV-029] the ExA is satisfied that, if required, any further inspections could be carried out on an unaccompanied or access only basis. As a result, the ExA has made the procedural decision not to hold an ASI and the Examination Timetable has been amended to reflect this.
- 4. **Dates reserved (if required):** As set out in its Rule 8 letter [PD-007] the ExA have reviewed the Applicant's preference raised at the Preliminary Meeting [EV-003] and repeated at ISH6 [EV-029] to present evidence in person at future ISHs. However, given that the majority of participants have indicated their intention to attend virtually, in the interests of efficiency and fairness the ExA has made the procedural decision that Hearings (if required) timetabled for the week commencing Monday 18 July 2022 will be held virtually on MS Teams.
