P2426 Kumatage – Hornsea Four Examination - Objection to Potential Order

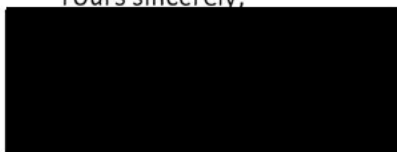
Thank you for your email dated 17 June attaching a draft order for possible submission ahead of Deadline 5 of the Hornsea Four Examination.

As you are aware, Bridge Petroleum 2 Limited (the company) currently holds licence P2426 and has done since 2018. During its tenure the company has expended significant resource in furthering its interests under the licence and those of other stakeholders pursuant to MER UK.

The company has been unable to agree the Heads of Terms referred to in your email because the proposals therein would likely hinder its ability to fulfil its obligations and enjoy the benefits under the current licence or indeed any oil and gas licence over the same area that may be granted in the future.

With reference to the proposed order, the company views clauses 4(2), 5, 6 and 7 as potentially deleterious to its interests and expressly does not agree to the order. The company continues expressly to reserve all its rights whether in law or equity or otherwise.
