Request for further information and written comments

The Examining Authority (ExA) notes that Natural England [page 122 of RR-029] deferred to NatureScot to comment on the suitability of the Applicant's assessment of impacts on the Moray Firth Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

The Applicant [page 404 of REP1-038] confirmed that Scottish Natural Heritage (now NatureScot) was issued with the draft Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) Screening Report and the draft report to inform the appropriate assessment (RIAA) during the pre-application phase and that no comments were received from NatureScot in relation to these communications.

The ExA therefore makes a written request for further information under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010. Could the Applicant direct NatureScot to the summary information about the bottlenose dolphin qualifying feature of the Moray Firth SAC in the Report on the Implications for European Sites (RIES) (Table 4.2, Moray Firth SAC section) [PD-015] and verify that NatureScot agrees with the conclusions of the Applicant, as recorded there. In brief, these are:

Protected site: Moray Firth SAC.

Qualifying feature: Bottlenose dolphin.



- Potential Adverse Effects on Integrity (AEoI): Increase in underwater noise (during construction and decommissioning).
- Potential AEoI: Vessel disturbance (all phases).
- Potential AEoI: Vessel collision risk (all phases).
- Summary: At application, in its RIAA [AS-014]¹, the Applicant concluded that no AEoI were likely. The supporting document B2.2, RIAA Part 12: Appendix G: Marine Mammals Bottlenose dolphin RIAA information [APP-178] provides the detail.

The ExA requires a response on this matter by Deadline 8 which is midday on Thursday 18 August 2022.
