Dear Sir/Madam

We write on behalf of our clients National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc (NGET) and National Grid Gas Plc (NGG), and confirm as follows:

- Acceptable agreed versions of the Order Protective Provisions for NGET and NGG respectively, have been submitted by the promoter at Deadline 7.
- However, whilst the Protective Provisions are agreed, the totality of the agreement is also predicated on agreement between the parties which is being tied up in confidential commercial arrangements which are also now substantially agreed but not executed. Should the promoter not proceed to enter into these commercial arrangements, then NGET and NGG each reserve the right to make further comments on the necessary wording in their respective Protective Provisions. However this is not anticipated to be the case and it is understood that all parties will now promptly move to execute the commercial arrangements between the parties accordingly.
