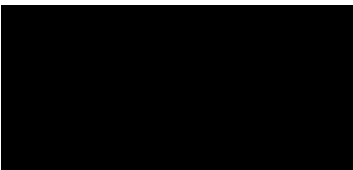
6. Question for the Maritime and Coastguard Agency
