**Paragraph 2 of Schedule 16: Plan for Work of the Offshore Ornithology Engagement Group (OOEG)**

Dear DESNZ,

Orsted Hornsea Project Four (UK) Limited (**Hornsea Four**) is writing to you in relation to the enclosed plan for the work of the OOEG for the kittiwake compensation measure required by schedule 16 of the Order (**Plan of Work**).

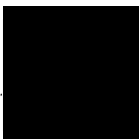
The Order requires the Plan of Work to be submitted to and approved by the Secretary of State prior to commencement of the authorised development. The Plan of Work must include details listed in sub-paragraphs (a) to (e) of paragraph 2 in relation to terms of reference, membership, scheduling of meetings and timetabling for preparation of the Kittiwake Compensation Implementation and Monitoring Plan (KCIMP).

Hornsea Four has prepared the Plan of Work following consultation with the members of the OOEG. The Plan of Work has been ratified by all core members (ratification letters enclosed). Core members of the OOEG, as named in Paragraph 2 of Schedule 16 of the Order, are Natural England, the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) and the States of Guernsey (representing themselves and the States of Alderney).

Hornsea Four therein provides the Plan of Work for the Secretary of States approval pursuant to paragraph 2 of the Order.
