Statement of Common Ground (Highways England)

1 Introduction

- 1.1 This Statement of Common Ground has been prepared as part of the application process for a Development Consent Order for the Little Crow Solar Park [“the Development”]. This document has been prepared jointly between the INRG Solar (Little Crow) Ltd. [“the Applicant”] and Highways England.
- 1.2 Highways England (HE) is the government company charged with operating, maintaining and improving England’s motorways and major A roads [“the Strategic Road Network”]. In relation to Development site, Highways England is responsible for the M180 which is located approximately 4.5 km to the south of the site.
- 1.3 All statements within this document are agreed between the Applicant and Highways England.

2 Matters Agreed

- 2.1 All traffic associated with the construction phase will follow the designated route as illustrated in Figure 3.1 of the Construction Traffic Management Plan.
- 2.2 The forecast number of construction vehicles set out Table 5.1 and Table 5.2 of the Construction Traffic Management Plan is accepted and will not have a material impact upon the capacity, operation and safety of the Strategic Road Network.
- 2.3 The measures set out in the Construction Traffic Management Plan are appropriate to manage the effects of construction traffic on the Strategic Road Network.
- 2.4 The Construction Traffic Management Plan will be secured by the requirements of the DCO.




