Dear Sir, Madam

We act for National Gas Transmission plc ("NGT") in relation to the Net Zero Teeside DCO and write in reply to the Secretary of State's letter of 10 March 2023, specifically in relation to the updates requested of NGT in paragraph 6. Please note that as of January 2023 National Grid Gas plc has changed its name to become National Gas Transmission plc and it is still the relevant gas undertaker for the purposes of the DCO.

NGT is close to agreeing final protective provisions with the applicant and is confident that final terms will be reached soon. There are very few outstanding matters of substance. However, NGT notes that the last dDCO submitted by the applicant does not contain up-to-date protective provisions that NGT require to protect its assets and interests impacted by the DCO and as such I am instructed to attach NGT's proposed protective provisions that it asks the Secretary of State and the applicant to include in the future iterations of the draft and final DCO.
