STATEMENT

 The Side Agreement between the Applicants and Anglo American has now been completed.

As a result:

- a. Anglo American are able to confirm that, subject to the inclusion in the NZT Order of the protective provisions for the benefit of Anglo American (Sch12 Part 17 of the draft DCO) and the protective provisions for the benefit of the Applicant (Sch 3 of the draft DCO) in the form preferred and set out by Anglo American in the Joint Statement submitted to the Examining Authority on 1 November 2022 (REP 12-130), Anglo American withdraws its objections to the NZT DCO.
- b. The Applicant confirms that it is content that the form of protective provisions preferred by Anglo American and set out in the Joint Statement submitted to the Examining Authority on 1 November 2022 (REP 12-130), be included in the final DCO.
- 3. Accordingly, the form of protective provisions now agreed by both parties are those contained in the draft DCO submitted to the Examining Authority on 1 November 2022 (REP12-003), which included the protective provisions in the form preferred by Anglo American. Anglo American and the Applicant agree that no alteration is necessary to the protective provisions in relation to Anglo American in that draft DCO.
