For the attention of the Inspectorate,

There needs to be a delay to the Preliminary Meeting (and the start of the Examination) as Sunnica are proposing a hugely significant change to their Development Consent Order (DCO) application. The delay is essential because a huge amount of the DCO application documents that have already been submitted will no longer be accurate, and will thus need to be amended. A delay would provide transparency, allowing all interested parties to review the changes and respond accordingly

Sunnica's suggested timetable for the assessment, evaluation, consultation, etc, of the new 'Option 3' is worryingly rushed. An organisation in this much of a hurry will have some ill thought out changes and when they affect the lives of over 40.000 people in over eight villages, adequate time must be allowed for these people to be consulted.

The shortage of time in the proposed timetable, will leave little chance for local people to review the changes. It feels like this is an underhand ploy to push these plans through before those affected have the chance to understand the changes and make themselves heard. There needs to be a proposed timetable that is fair, and appropriate to allow for fair participation. If this cannot be agreed, the application should be withdrawn and resubmitted once they have their plans in order.
