Re: Request by the Applicant in Respect of the Timing of the Preliminary Meeting / Examination.

I would like to hereby submit my views as a local resident.

I am in favour of delaying the Preliminary Meeting (and the start of the Examination) as Sunnica are proposing a significant change to their Development Consent Order (DCO) application. I strongly feel that the delay should be long enough to ensure that residents have access to full details of the scheme changes and the impacts to allow fair participation. Also to allow a fair assessment during the tight timetable once the Examination process begins.

I object to the brisk timetable proposed by Sunnica for the assessment, evaluation, consultation etc, for the change implementation and do not feel it allows sufficient assessment to protect residents against significant potential impact on landscape, traffic, construction, wildlife, infrastructure, amongst other things.

There will also not be significant time for residents to review the materials, that Sunnica will need to reproduce, adequately. Especially considering this is proposed during peak holiday season.

I strongly believe that a fair timetable needs to be determined to enable fair participation. If this cannot be agreed, the application should be withdrawn and resubmitted once they have their plans in order, or withdrawn completely.
