Dear Examining Authority members.

I do not think that Sunnica's request for an extension should be granted. The guidance from Central Government relating to an acceptable timetable is there for a reason to prevent this type of occurrence.

The fact that Sunnica has failed to get assurance from National Grid (certainly their main stakeholder) is another example of the cavalier attitude Sunnica has displayed during the lead up to this application being submitted.

Sunnica's has completely ignored the concerns of local people, failed to properly engage with them or listen to legitimate concerns. They have assumed everything will be "waved through" in the frantic rush to increase renewable energy production, even though this scheme is clearly misplaced and seriously flawed on every level.

The delay is being sought for Sunnica to investigate a 3rd option for connection to the Burwell Grid - but this 3rd option was previously dismissed by Sunnica before the application was submitted as being **too risky**. How is it that this 3rd option appears to be Sunnica's preferred (only) option now? It suggests desperation on their part.

This lack of thoroughness and due diligence by Sunnica in their dealings with National Grid is very worrying and typifies their arrogant approach to this appalling scheme.

The request for a delay should be refused and the scheme should be abandoned entirely.
