Dear Sirs

The recently disclosed lack of connectivity to the Burwell sub-station, I imagine, renders the current application submitted by Sunnica void, and will require considerable reevaluation of the application both on technical grounds alongside any impact any changes will have on the local environs.

As to whether the application should be withdrawn is a point for the Planning Inspectorate, however, I would ask that there should be sufficient time for the developer to reconsider the application and for their work to be thorough so that stakeholders have a full understanding of any impact, and for them have to have enough time to be fully consulted and represented.

For this process to happen in a complete manner I would imagine the Examination period will continue into the autumn to make allowance for summer holidays. In this instance I am not sure whether you consider this extension breaches the government guidelines. In my limited understanding of these matters, I believe it might well.
