Delay in Preliminary Meeting

I object to a delay with the Preliminary Meeting. The meeting should go ahead in accordance with normal time-scales for this type of development. I am very concerned of the implications of this scheme being allowed to change direction at whim.

Timetable for Further Consultation

Sunnica are proposing significant changes to their original plan and documentation. National Grid have dismissed Sunnica's preferred site (Option 1). Sunnica next considers a compulsory purchase at Burwell (Option 2), and if that is not feasible a new substation (Option 3) at Chippenham. Their proposed timescales are totally unrealistic if **all** residents, landowners and affected parties are to be properly consulted on these major changes. We have no idea of the impact of the new option(s) and thorough consultation and scrutiny regarding these changes is absolutely vital - **two months is inadequate**.

Sunnica are unprepared for this vast scheme.
