I would ask that the deadline for written representations be moved back to 20th September so we can prepare our Written Reps properly.


2/ It will be unfairly complicated also to run the examination before the Applicant has submitted his altered DCO Application. It is daunting enough dealing with this procedure, but to try and run the two together will put us at a significant disadvantage in the process. As an item on the Preliminary Meeting Agenda is to receive an update on the application I can't see how this is going to be possible.

 - d/ The consultation with the Traveller Community Permanent Caravan and Mobile Home Park Elms Road Red Lodge
