Final Itineraries for Accompanied Site Inspections 2 (ASI2) on Wednesday 2 November 2022 and 3 (ASI3) on Thursday 3 November 2022

The final itineraries for ASI2 and ASI3 are below.

Please note that the Examining Authority's (ExA) inspection of sites is **not** an opportunity to provide any oral representations on the project or discuss evidence. It is an opportunity for the ExA to look at the physical features that can be seen on, or from the sites. Participants may be invited by the ExA to point out specific features or sites of interest.

Joining the site inspections

ASI2 - Wednesday 2 November 2022

The site inspection will take place in two parts – morning and afternoon. The meeting place for both parts is Red Lodge Sports Pavilion, Hundred Acre Way, Red Lodge, Bury Saint Edmunds IP28 8FQ. The morning part will start at **9:00** and the afternoon part will start at **14:00**.

ASI3 - Thursday 3 November 2022

The site inspection will take place in two parts – morning and afternoon. The meeting place for both parts is Red Lodge Sports Pavilion, Hundred Acre Way, Red Lodge, Bury Saint Edmunds IP28 8FQ. The morning part will start at **9:00** and the afternoon part will start at **13:45**.

Those Interested Parties who have requested to attend ASI2 and/or ASI3 in accordance with our Rule 8 letter of 4 October 2022 [PD-016] have been contacted to confirm their attendance. Those attending are asked to assemble promptly as the ExA will not wait for parties who are not present at the start time.

In view of a busy ASI schedule and reduced daylight hours it will be important to adhere as closely as possible to the timetable. The routes will involve walking along tracks and across fields to reach viewpoints and to rendezvous with transport. This will mean that it will be difficult for participants to join or leave the ASIs part way along a route.

To ensure the smooth running of the ExA's inspections, participants should notify the Case Team if there are any changes in attendance and ensure the Planning Inspectorate is made aware of any special access requirements.

Clothing

The inspections will include considerable walking on uneven or wet ground and weather conditions may vary during the day. We therefore advise participants to wear suitable clothing and sturdy footwear. The Applicant will provide high visibility jackets.

Sites on private land

Access onto private land is at all times by permission of the person controlling it; householders, occupiers and landowners may refuse to allow some persons accompanying the ExA onto their land. Under those circumstances, the ExA will decide whether or not to proceed with that part of the inspection and may ask those refused access to wait outside.

Refreshments

Please note refreshments will not be provided.

Detailed itineraries

The ExA has given careful consideration to the <u>Applicant's draft itineraries</u> [REP1-001] and also to the representations made at Deadline 1 in relation to the ASIs [REP1-040; REP1-044; REP1-045]. Revised itineraries for both ASI2 and ASI3 have been produced by the ExA which make adjustments to timings in order to ensure that the routes can be completed during daylight, to allow for lunch breaks and to give attendees the opportunity to leave or join ASIs at lunch time on both days. The ExA's final itineraries for ASI2 and ASI3 are set out in **Annex A** to this letter.

Where it has not been possible to accommodate suggestions for additional stops or viewpoints, the ExA will endeavour to visit them later in the Examination, although this may be on an unaccompanied basis.

Participants should note the details provided in the itineraries, particularly in respect of clothing, and health and safety.

The Applicant will provide copies of the plans and photomontages listed in tables 1 to 4 and Figures 1 to 4 of the itineraries, for all participants.


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Figure 1 – Proposed route during the morning of ASI2
