Draft itinerary for ASI4

The Applicant notes that the ExA's letter dated 21 November 2022, which amended the examination timetable, requested that the Applicant submit a draft itinerary for ASI4, which is proposed to take place on 15 February 2023. The Applicant notes the direction given by the case officer that the ExA's intention is to use ASI4 to complete visits to the locations that

interested parties were unable to visit during ASI3 due to the poor weather on the morning of 3 November 2022.

The Applicant therefore proposes an updated version of the itinerary that was originally proposed for ASI3 prior to the cancellation of the morning session. This omits the visit to La Hogue Farm Shop and Café that was completed on 3 November 2022. This updated itinerary is outlined below and in Figure 1.

In addition to preparing the below draft itinerary, the Applicant suggests the following arrangements for the ASI.

Meeting point

The proposed ASI meeting point is at Red Lodge Sports Pavilion, Hundred Acre Way, Red Lodge, Bury Saint Edmunds IP28 8FQ at 09:00.

Free parking and toilet facilities are available at the meeting point from which attendees will take transport (pre-arranged by the Applicant) to the ASI. The transport will return attendees to the Red Lodge Sports Pavilion following the ASI. Attendees should make their own arrangements for travelling to and from the Red Lodge Sports Pavilion.

Greeting by the ExA

The Applicant proposes that the ExA welcomes and briefs attendees at the meeting point prior to departure to the inspection locations.

Lunch

A small supermarket and food outlets are located within walking distance of the Red Lodge Sports Pavilion at Bellflower Crescent.

Health and safety

The Applicant has provided a health and safety pro forma to the Planning Inspectorate separately to the draft itinerary for ASI4.

While Government guidance no longer requires self-isolation in relation to testing positive for COVID-19, the Applicant requests that any attendees who feel unwell do not attend the site visit.

The Applicant will carry out a briefing at the start of the ASI. This will aim to ensure that visitors are aware of any potential health and safety issues and has been informed by a walk of the route carried out beforehand.

The ASI will involve walking through agricultural land, field boundaries and public rights of way (PRoWs). Those that are likely to find it challenging to walk significant distances on this terrain are advised to assess whether it is suitable to attend, either partially or in its entirety, the ASI.

A first aid kit will be provided on the transport.

Clothing

While steel toe capped boots are not necessary, sturdy walking footwear will be required. The conditions in certain areas of the site will mean that wellington boots are recommended. The ASI will involve exiting the transport and crossing local roads which have limited visibility. All attendees will therefore be required to wear high visibility jackets at all times during the ASI. The Applicant will provide the high visibility clothing.

Foliage adjacent to PRoWs and around field boundaries can be of considerable height and therefore attendees are requested to choose clothing that keeps their arms and legs covered at all times when attending the ASI. The ASI will involve a significant amount of walking. As such attendees are requested to dress appropriately for the weather.
