Thank you for your Deadline 6 submissions as listed in your cover letter dated 30 January 2023, which will be published on the project page of the Planning Inspectorate's website shortly.

We note that the following documents were not submitted and that you propose to submit them by Wednesday 8 February 2023:

1. Updated ES Appendix 10I - Outline Landscape and Ecology Management Plan [EN010106/APP/6.2];
2. Updated Environmental Master Plan (Zoomed Out) [EN010106/APP/8.47];
3. Updated Environmental Master Plan (Zoomed In) [EN010106/APP/8.77];
4. Updated Outline Construction Traffic Management Plan [EN010106/APP/6.2];
5. Biodiversity Position Statement in advance of Second Hearings;
6. LVIA Position Statement in advance of Second Hearings;
7. Draft protective provisions for the benefit of the local highway authorities;
8. Crash site exclusion area plan [EN010106/8.89]; and
9. Potential expanded crash site exclusion area plan [EN010106/8.90].

In addition, the Examining Authority (ExA) does not appear to have received the hedgerow plan requested in ExQ2.7.3 which you undertook in [REP5-056] to submit at Deadline 6, or the details of the cable crossing across Chippenham Park Avenue requested in ExQ2.4.1 and which you stated had been submitted at D5.

As you will be aware, it is standard practice for the ExA to publish detailed agendas at least 7 days in advance of Issue Specific Hearings to give all parties sufficient time to prepare: the Examination Timetable is prepared and Deadlines set with this in mind. Consequently, late submission of documents causes inconvenience both to the ExA and to other Parties when preparing for hearings.

In view of the above, please submit these documents **as a matter of urgency** to enable the ExA to finalise and publish detailed agendas and to enable all parties to effectively prepare for the Hearings.

Please ensure that **all documents referred to above are also provided as tracked change documents** to assist the ExA and Interested Parties.
