To the planning inspectorate

It is very difficult to comment on Sunnica's responses to the most recent information request by the planning inspectorate. The responses they give do not supply the information requested clearly enough and are convoluted and vague.

The whole application has been poorly prepared and seems designed to distract from the fact that the project has not been properly thought through and is taking away good quality farming land when we need to be more self reliant in growing our own food.

Sunnica's response to item 2: BATTERY ENERGY STORAGE SYSTEM DESIGN AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE beggars belief.

These huge batteries are planned to be placed near villages and schools and, as seen in recent battery fires, cause toxic smoke and cannot easily be extinguished.

This seems to be the attitude that Sunnica have had in their dealings with the local community too. They do not seem to see the need to give sufficient information or communicate effectively with the local population.

I am very concerned about Sunnica's proposal and I strongly object to it being granted planning permission.
