Thank you for your consultation on the above dated 14 December 2023 which was received by Natural England on the same date.

Natural England is a non-departmental public body. Our statutory purpose is to ensure that the natural environment is conserved, enhanced, and managed for the benefit of present and future generations, thereby contributing to sustainable development.

Natural England has not yet completed the draft evidence document regarding its research into the functional linkage of stone curlew populations of the Breckland SPA and therefore it is not publicly available. There is further work required but we do not have any timescales for this or the date of publication. The report as published is unlikely to change our advice provided to date for this proposed development.
