Following the request for further info and response from Sunnica dated 15th Jan, I would like to reiterate yet again how firmly opposed to this scheme I am based on the many concerns that I have previously raised as a long term resident of the area concerned - farmland, countryside, the rich wildlife, the already overwhelmed roads and country lanes, fire risk to the local school close by, the impact on mental health as fields and walking routes disappear under what can only be discribed as a profit making scheme by Sunnica.

The latest survey by CPRE shows strong public support for rooftop solar and a desire to protect food security. Research by UCL Energy Institute published last year showed there is plenty of rooftop/ car park space to easily achieve 40-50 GW solar...and with investment considerably more.
