Please see below the comments of Freckenham Parish Council in relation to the latest information received.

- reaffirm position of rection and stand by all the points we have made previously.
- comment about huge landscape impact, that Freckenham would be almost entirely surrounded by this development and dispute the idea that the scheme was landscape-led, as the reality does not align with this, nor does the evidence provided by landscape expert Michelle Bolger Expert Landscape Consultancy, who FPC support (submissions from Michelle Bolger were presented via the Say No to Sunnica group).
- fail to see how NE can adopt a position regarding the linkage of stone curlew populations within and outside the scheme boundary as they have no complete and published studies to support this. The mention of 'further work' being needed for their current study, combined with the many inadequacies on stone curlew issues that were highlighted throughout the examination, means that caution is needed.

FPC considers that a decision cannot be taken based on assumptions.
