We have read and considered the latest letters from both Natural England and the applicant.

Natural England have still not provided clarity about the state of the local stone curlew population, and until this is completed the Sunnica proposal must be considered a risk to these endangered birds.

Regarding the applicant's reply: this proposed scheme is so vast and widespread that it is hard to see how it can possibly be mitigated. It will have an enormous detrimental effect on the entire area and completely destroy the rural landscape. It is completely at odds with the Design Principles for Infrastructure Projects, as detailed in our previous submissions.

Once more, we implore you to reject this proposal completely.
