I write with regard to the inspector's letter requesting updates from Sunnica.

I feel that both Sunnica's and Natural England response is disappointing.

Firstly, Natural England's reply shows very little regard for the Stone Curlew, which is a protected Bird. They shows no sign that the report will be completed soon. Very disappointing for a Public Body whose statutory purpose is to ensure that the Natural environments is conserved and enhanced.

Sunnica have not been able to answer the questions. Instead repeating the statements, they have previously given and not trying to mitigate the visual impact, minimizing damage to the countryside or the Glint and Glare assessment. If Sunnica are unable to reassure us on these issues, why should we have any confidence that the larger safety issues such as the storage batteries are safe in their hands.
