Summary of key points discussed and advice given

Introduction

The Applicant and the Planning Inspectorate (the Inspectorate) case team introduced themselves and their respective roles. The Inspectorate outlined its openness policy and ensured those present understood that any issues discussed and advice given would be recorded and placed on the Inspectorate's website under s51 of the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008). Further to this, it was made clear that any advice given did not constitute legal advice upon which the Applicant (or others) can rely.

Project Update

The Applicant advised that some of their Preliminary Environmental Impact Report documents were unavailable on their consultation website at the start of their statutory consultation. Therefore the consultation period has been extended to 16 October 2020. The Applicant advised that they are currently reviewing their timetable for submission of the application.

The Applicant advised that they intend to submit draft documents for review by the Inspectorate. The Inspectorate advised that the Applicant should allow 6-8 weeks in their timetable for this, dependant on when and which documents are submitted.

The Applicant advised that Compulsory Acquisition will now be included in the application. The Applicant is not seeking to acquire any new land but there are some outstanding interests in the site for which the Applicant would like to clear the title.

Specific decisions / follow up required?

The Applicant will update the Planning Inspectorate on their revised timetable as soon as they are able to.

The Planning Inspectorate and Applicant will arrange a further meeting to discuss the format of application documents.
