Development: Adequacy of consultation request for an Application by Equinor for an Order granting Development Consent

Site: Sheringham and Dudgeon Extension Projects EN010109

This off shore wind farm extension is located off the North Norfolk Coast and connects into the national grid at a substation located to the south of Norwich.

As a result it does not impact on the Borough Council's land or marine (to the mean low water spring line) territory.

The only indirect impact is to the town's fisherman, if the windfarms are constructed in areas where they fish.

The applicants advertised the project in the Fishing News on 29/04/2021, consulted the National Federation of Fisherman's' Organisations, Greater Wash Fishing Industry Group, Independent Fisherman, Eastern Sea Fisheries JC, amongst others that relate to Norfolk.

They have therefore sort to make the project known to the town's fisherman and have adequately consulted.
