I HEREBY certify that, in compliance with the requirements of Section 56 of the Planning Act 2008 –

- (a) notice of the accepted application was given to the required persons identified in accordance with Section 56;
- (b) a copy of the accepted application and accompanying documents and information was made available to the required persons; and
- (c) the accepted application was published in the required manner

in relation to the application for an order to grant development consent to construct, operate, maintain, and decommission two offshore wind farms known as the Sheringham Shoal Extension Project ("SEP") and the Dudgeon Extension Project ("DEP"), located approximately 13.6 km and 24.8 km north of the North Norfolk coast for SEP and DEP, respectively.

SEP and DEP will include both offshore and onshore infrastructure including offshore generating stations, which comprises up to 23 wind turbines and up to 30 wind turbines for SEP and DEP, respectively. SEP and DEP will be connected to shore by offshore export cables installed to the landfall at Weybourne, on the north Norfolk coast. From there, the onshore export cables travel approximately 60km inland to a new high voltage alternating current (HVAC) onshore substation near to the existing Norwich Main substation.

The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Planning Inspectorate under Section 56 was 11:59pm on 14 November 2022.
