Application by Equinor for an order granting development consent for the Sheringham and Dudgeon Extension Projects (EN010109)

## Amendment to the appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on Monday 3 October 2022. On Wednesday 19 October 2022 a document was published confirming that Menaka Sahai (lead), Jonathan Manning, David Wallis, Deborah McCann and Christine Fraser had been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application for the Sheringham and Dudgeon Extension Projects.
