Clicking on specific catchments within the online viewer will give access to more detailed maps which includes most ordinary watercourses present. Please be advised that the Board regulates all ordinary watercourses within the Internal Drainage District, and applies additional Byelaws (all Byelaws available here) to those watercourses designated as Arterial (labelled "IDB watercourses" in the above linked mapping) as they normally receive maintenance from the IDB directly due to their acknowledged importance to the drainage of the catchment as a whole.
