I write as agent for John Barnard (identification number 20033228) in connection with his land (sheet 34 of 40 Land Plan-Onshore) as affected by the proposed Sheringham Shoal and Dudgeon Offshore Windfarm Extension Projects.

With reference to the attached plan and the "Land Subject to Temporary Occupation and Use", I note it is proposed to gain access to the Order Limits via route A-B with the access from the B1172 Road at point A.

The proposed access at point A adjoins residential property/a car sales garage to the east, allows no "pull in" space before it meets/crosses the cycleway and is impractical for frequent use.

As I have previously put forward, access should be taken at point C, (approximately) a dedicated and gated accessway to the field which will allow safe crossing of the cycleway. It is also considerably nearer to point B (Order Limits) than the access point A and will, therefore, reduce the length of the access/land take on the land.

Could this access route amendment please be incorporated if/when the DCO is granted. Should a site meeting be required to understand the position on the ground, Mr Barnard or I would be happy to attend.
