NATS are aware the Examining Authority have requested its attendance at the Issue Specific Hearing 6 on the Friday the 31st of March. NATS do not plan to attend this hearing, however, it would like the Examiners to accept the statement below as an update to its position regarding Agenda Item 6i.

With reference to the Sheringham and Dudgeon Extension Projects, NATS anticipates an impact upon its infrastructure and its operation from the application, and as such has objected to the development.
