2. Format of Hearings

All Hearings will be Blended events. Blended events allow attendance both in-person and virtually through Microsoft Teams. The Hearings will be livestreamed and a link will be posted on the <u>project webpage</u> before the start of the event

4. Procedure at Hearings

The Examination will principally be a written process (see the Planning Inspectorate's <u>Advice Note 8.4: The Examination</u>), supplemented where necessary by various types of Hearings. Please refer to the <u>Advice Note 8.5: Hearings and site inspections</u> and <u>Advice Note 8.6: Virtual Examination events</u> as these provide important information about Hearing procedures.

The procedure to be followed at Hearings is set out in Rule 14 of the EPR. The ExA is responsible for the oral questioning of Interested Parties or Other Persons giving evidence and **will not allow cross-questioning** between parties.

5. The ExA's Procedural Decision relating to holding further Hearings in accordance with CA Regulations s14, s15 and s16

Further to the ExA's decision to accept the Applicant's request to make a material change to the application on 17 April 2023 [PD-014], the ExA is required to meet s14, s15, and s16 of the CA Regulations, relating to holding further Hearings.

Upon receiving the Certificates of Compliance in line with Regulation 9 of the CA Regulations on 29 May 2023, the ExA will re-issue this Rule 13 notification to confirm ISH7 in line with the requirements in s14(2) of the CA Regulations, giving 21 days' notice to any additional affected persons or interested parties of the date, time and place fixed for the further issue-specific hearing.

In line with s15(1)(a) and (b), and s16(1)(a) and (b), in a subsequent issuance, the ExA will ask for notifications from additional affected persons and additional interested parties if they wish to be heard at a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing and at an Open Floor Hearing. The ExA will issue a Procedural Decision to address any requests if received, in line with s15(2)(3) and s16(2)(3).



6. Cancellation

If any of the above Hearings are no longer required then notification will be published as soon as practicable on the <u>project webpage</u>, providing reasonable notice to all parties of the decision to cancel them.
