Changes to the Examination Timetable and other Procedural Decisions

1. Applicant's change request

Following our acceptance of the Applicant's recent request for changes to the Proposed Development by the Examining Authority (ExA) with the letter dated 17 April 2023 [PD-014], the Applicant has certified that this change to the Proposed Development has been notified and publicised in accordance with Regulations 7 and 8 of the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 (CA Regulations).

Relevant Representations in accordance with Regulation 10 of the CA Regulations were invited on the Applicant's proposed provision for the Compulsory Acquisition (CA) of additional land from 20 April to 26 May 2023. Subsequently, the Applicant submitted a Certificate of Compliance [OD-008] [OD-009] in line with Regulation 9 of the CA Regulations, which was received in Examination and accepted by the ExA on 29 May 2023.



Upon receiving the Certificates of Compliance from the Applicant, the ExA is making several Procedural Decisions to meet the CA Regulations and enable robust Examination of the changes to the Applications within the Examination.

2. ExA's Initial Assessment of Principal Issues

In line with Regulation 11 of the CA Regulations, the ExA has made a further assessment of principal issues and finds that the ExA's initial assessment [PD-006, Annex C] remains unchanged on account of the Applicant's change request. In that regard, the ExA does not find it necessary to hold a meeting to discuss how the proposed provision should be examined.

3. Changes to the Examination Timetable

As a consequence of the accepted change request and the necessary consultation arising from this, and in line with Regulation 12 of the CA Regulations, it is necessary to amend the Examination Timetable under Rule 8(3) of EPR. This letter provides the updated Examination Timetable at Annex A, which replaces the version that was included in the Rule 8 letter of 27 January 2023 [PD-009]. The changes to the Examination Timetable are necessary to ensure that the Applicant's change request can be robustly assessed within the Examination timeframe. The changes are summarised below.

- Deadlines 6 and 7 have now become Deadlines 7 and 8 with some changes to what is expected at those deadlines.
- A new Deadline has been inserted on Tuesday 20 June, which is now Deadline 6, and will allow for submissions of responses to Relevant Representations on the material change request, and receipt of Written Representations on the material change to the Proposed Development.
- The ExA may issue fourth Written Questions, if required, to be published on Thursday 29 June.

4. Written Representations

In line with Regulation 13 of the CA Regulations, the ExA is inviting all Interested Parties to submit written representations on the changes to the Proposed Development to amend the Application. Any additional Affected Persons and additional Interested Parties are invited to submit Written Representations on the Application as a whole. Please do not repeat any representations already made. The Written Representations are due by **Deadline 6, Tuesday 20 June 2023**. In doing so, the ExA is giving the required 21 days' notice to parties.

Any Written Representations which exceed 1500 words should also be accompanied by a summary which should not exceed 10% of the original text. The summary



should set out the key facts of the written submission and must be representative of the submission made. Representations must not include hyperlinks to documents/evidence hosted on third party websites. Please see the Planning Inspectorate's Advice Note 8.4: The Examination for further information about Written Representations

5. Notification to hold Issue Specific Hearing in line with CA Regulation 14

The ExA will hold an Issue Specific Hearing (ISH7) in line with the requirements in Regulation 14(2) of the CA Regulations. The ExA issued a notification under Rule 13 of EPR on 22 May 2023 [PD-016] and is reconfirming the notification to parties of its intention to hold ISH7 (if required) on 21 June 2023. In doing so, the ExA is giving the required 21 days' notice to any additional affected persons or interested parties of the date, time and place fixed for the further Issue Specific Hearing.

6. Request for Compulsory Acquisition Hearing and Open Floor Hearing in line with CA Regulations 15 and 16

In line with Regulations 15(1)(a) and (b), and 16(1)(a) and (b) of the CA Regulations, the ExA requests that additional Affected Persons and additional Interested Parties inform us if they wish to be heard at a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing and at an Open Floor Hearing. Any requests must be received by **Deadline 6, Tuesday 20 June 2023**.

In the Rule 13 notification issued on 22 May 2023 [PD-016] the ExA has provisionally set dates and times for a further Open Floor Hearing (OFH3) and a further Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH2). The ExA is reconfirming the notification to parties of its intention to hold OFH3 (if required) on 21 June 2023, and CAH2 (if required) on 22 June 2023. In doing so, the ExA is giving the required 21 days' notice in line with Regulations 15(2) and 16(2), to any additional affected persons or interested parties of the date, time and place fixed for the further Compulsory Acquisition Hearing and Open Floor Hearing.
