1 Purpose of this Document

1. This is a joint statement between Equinor New Energy Limited (the Applicant) and Norfolk County Council (NCC) in relation to the Sheringham Shoal Offshore Wind Farm Extension Project (SEP) and Dudgeon Offshore Wind Farm Extension Project (DEP) Development Consent Order (DCO) application. It confirms the latest position in respect of the negotiation of a voluntary agreement between the Applicant and NCC and agreed timescales for its completion.

2 Matters that are Agreed

- 2. Heads of Terms setting out the basis of the voluntary agreement for land at Marriott's Way were issued to NCC on 13th July 2022.
- 3. Whilst not returning a signed copy of the Heads of Terms, NCC confirmed that they were agreed on 6th December 2022 and instructed their legal representatives to commence negotiations with the Applicant on the draft option agreement.
- 4. The draft option agreement was issued to NCC's legal representatives on 23rd May 2023 and is currently being negotiated with the legal representatives of the Applicant.
- 5. The Applicant and NCC acknowledge that the voluntary agreement will not be agreed prior to the close of Examination, however both parties hope that it will be possible to complete the agreement by 1st December 2023.
