We act on behalf of National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc ("**NGET**") in relation to the application for The Sheringham Shoal and Dudgeon Extensions Offshore Windfarm Order (the "**Application**").

We write to provide an update on behalf of NGET for the purposes of **Deadline 8** of the Examination.

NGET has previously submitted both a Relevant Representation [RR-058] and a Written Representation [REP1-127 to REP1-130] in this matter. A further submission was provided on behalf of NGET at Deadline 5 [REP5-084].

With reference to the agreed status update set out on pages 12 and 13 of "*The Applicant's Statutory Undertakers Position Statement (Revision D)*" submitted for Deadline 7, we note that commercial terms between the Applicant and NGET have now been agreed but not yet fully formalised. The process for formalising those terms will take place in the coming weeks, following which NGET would intend to write to the Examining Authority and/or the Secretary of State in order to provide a further update and to withdraw its existing objection to the Application.

However, and for the avoidance of doubt, NGET must continue to maintain its objection to the Application until that further update is provided.

NGET would be pleased to provide the Examining Authority with any further information required in the intervening period.
