Further to your letter of the 22<sup>nd</sup> November, I am writing to update you on the current position.

Equinor and the National Trust's advisers have agreed a way forward in principle that we hope will ultimately allow the withdrawal of the Trust's objection to the granting of the DCO. We are moving at pace to finalise the detail and work through the necessary internal governance procedures, but are aware that the Christmas break may hamper a speedy resolution."
